Top 11 Plants To Grow For New Gardeners

Podcast Notes from Interview with Randel Agrella, Horticulturist Parsnippty Farm, Fort Fairfield Maine

- 1. Bush Beans: Remember there are 2 varieties of beans pole and bush. Randel is recommends bush. No staking required!
- 2. Lettuce (likes cooler weather: spring and fall
- 3. Snap Peas (likes cooker weather: spring and fall
- 4. Cucumbers (likes hot weather)
- 5. Summer Squash (likes hot weather)
- 6. Kale: Dinosaur Kale is nice. It has tender leaves and it's easy to chop, cook and eat.

Root Veggies:

- 7. Carrots (plant in spring and harvest after frost)
- 8. Beets (plant in spring and harvest after frost)
- 9. Turnips (plant in spring and harvest after frost)

Herbs:

- 10. Basil (likes hot weather)
- 11. Parsley (if growing from seed, be patient. Seeds take a long time to germinate likes cool weather and is a biannual. Comes back every 2 years if allowed to take root in garden.
